- Be mindful that individual needs vary: Remember that individual hydration needs may differ based on body weight, sweat rate, and environmental conditions. Experiment and adjust your drinking routine to find what works best for you.
- Listen to your body: Pay attention to signs of dehydration, such as excessive thirst, dizziness, fatigue, or decreased performance.
 If you experience any of these symptoms, take a break, rehydrate, and rest in a cool, shaded area.
