## Bluewater praises Nordic governments call for global agreement to tackle ocean plastic pollution

Stockholm, Sweden, April 11, 2019 – <u>Bluewater</u>, a world leader in innovative water purification technology and solutions, has praised Nordic governments for jointly agreeing a call to action on reducing and preventing plastic waste and micro-plastics discharged into the sea.

The call resulted from a meeting of the environment ministers of Denmark, Finland, Iceland, Norway and Sweden at the Nordic Council in Reykjavik,

Iceland.

In a joint <u>declaration</u> the ministers stressed that pollution of the world's oceans is a global problem, and that more concrete measures need to be implemented globally in order to make progress on the issue.

The Nordic governments stressed that plastic pollution in our seas and oceans is a worldwide environmental problem posing a threat to life and ecosystems and affecting fisheries, maritime transport, outdoor recreation, tourism, and other areas of concern. Their statement was sent to EU governing bodies, UNEP, the G7, and the G20.
